Next evening. I didn't have time to finish my letter yesterday so I will have a go at it tonight. I have just finished my homework for tonight and it is now half past eleven. i.e. 11.30.

Tonight my homework included Physics & chemistry notes to copy down, a German translation, a map & geography to learn some English analysis, arithmetic and a bit of ~~hys~~ history, so you can see I really have not much time to write letters.

It pleases me to hear about your change of master, I hope you like the new ones.

Well there is one little question that I would like to ask you. Are still all the old familiar faces in the class or have some be kicked out of
