Enlisting 1st March, 1916, and sailing on hospital ship "Karoola" in May after service at No. 4 Australian General Hospital, Randwick, joined No. 2 Australian General Hospital, Wimereux, 3rd September and 8th Australian Field Ambulance on 14th, becoming R.M.O. 30th Battn. and remaining with it until demobilisation, though slightly gassed in April, 1918. Awarded M.C.\* for work at Polygon Wood, 30th September, 1917, and Mentioned in Despatches. Early education at Fort St. High School.
