Enlisted in 4th Bn. Commission as 1st Lieutenant dated 28th Aug 1914. Served in Egypt and Gallipoli till Aug 1915. Present at Landing at Lone Pine mentioned in Despatches for service in latter action. In Hospital at Port Said and invalided to Australia. Posted to 36th Bn in Australia March 1916. Embarked HMAT Beltana 13th May 1916. Served with 36th Bn and 3rd Divisional H.Q. till Feb'y 1917. Transferred to 44th Bn and joined unit in France in April 1917. In Action with 44th Battalion at Demicourt (in April 1917) Bullecourt (May 1917) Zonnebeker Passchendaele Ridge (Nov. 1917) Strazeele Hazebrouck (April 1918) Amiens (Aug 1918) Commanded 1st Training Bn. England Oct Nov + Dec. 1918. Commanded 1st Training Bde Concentration Depot Jan Feb'y March April June 1919.
