Dear Sir:

Re Your enquiry as to Mr H Thomson  
Mr Thomson enlisted on the 22<sup>nd</sup> July 1915 and  
while in Camp was appointed Lieutenant.

He left South Australia on the 11<sup>th</sup> January last  
and arrived in Egypt some time in February  
while in Egypt he got what he called in a  
letter home his second star and was appointed  
Lieutenant so I presume the appointment of  
officers here and in the field are somewhat  
different. He left Egypt & arrived in France  
about the 16<sup>th</sup> June last and has been with  
the capture of 3 days leave on active service

since the last mentioned date  
He was reported wounded by the military  
authorities but this was evidently a  
mistake as I have received a letter  
since that report - dated two days  
subsequent - he mentioned that he  
was feeling fit well had been in  
some of the big engagements in France  
I know for certain that the report as  
to the wounding was an error on the  
part of the military authorities

Trusting the above information will be  
of interest to those who attend the  
Commemoration
