left Australia with

10 Reinf. to 53rd Battalion. Owing to lack of reinf. in England volunteered for artillery and transferred to 39th Battery 4th Division. In action at Kemel and from before Harbonniers and through Hindenburg line until Armistice. Proceeded to Belgium with the Battery and left with our last draft for Australia. Service abroad extending over two years, twenty five days.
