Transferring to No. 2 Australian Stationary Hospital, Moascar, was with 3rd A.L.H. Bde. F.Amb. in Tripoli from October to March, 1919, and served during Egyptian Rebellion at Zag-a-Zig, later being at A.I.F. H.Q., Cairo, until demobilisation.
