Full details and remarks as to service:—

Left with 9th Batt. , attached to 1st L.H. Bde. , Served in Egypt and landed Gallipoli with Light Horse on 12/5/1915. Appointed Senior-Chaplain to Lieut -General Godley's Division (N.Z. & A.) but continued to live with 1st L.H. Regt. Left Gallipoli on 27/10/1915, suffering from Malaria. Returned to Australia, arriving Sydney 4/1/1916. Resumed duty as Senior Chaplain (Presbyterian), 1st Mil. Distr. Re-enlisted at Brisbane and gazetted A.I.F. 29/12/1917 date of embarkation. Arrived England 21/3/1918. Served in England - 3rd A.A. Hospl., Dartford, Kent to 25/4/1918 when took up duty at Australian Hqrs. at Tidworth, Salisbury Plain. Crossed to France, 5/7/1918, & served at Australian Infantry Base Depot, Rouelles. On 26/10/1918 appointed to 2nd Divl. Troops, attached to 5th Bde., A. Field Artillery; and served with this unit in France & Belgium. Left England on H.M.T. Devanha, 9/5/1919, arriving Sydney 26/6/1919. Appointment terminated 20/7/1919. Resumed duty as S-C. (Pres.), 1st Mil. District.
