Full details and remarks as to service: I enlisted at Victoria Barracks, Sydney, on 15/1/16 & on 17th. I was drafted to Coasled encampment. By the examinations held in November, 1915, I had completed the Leaving Certificate & matriculation examinations, so that I joined up fresh from school. at Coasled I was drafted into the 7th reinforcements of the 5th. F.A. B. & sent to the Agric. Show Ground, Thence I passed to a camp in Addison Rd. Warrickville & from there I went to The Warren, to become a member of the 4th reinforcements of the 22nd. Hewitzer Bde. The "Orsova" took me to England, where I was successively in Park House & Park Hill camps. I arrived in France via Boulogne & St. Omer. I passed through the 2nd. D.A.C. to the 104th. Battery & with that unit I served until hostilities ended. I returned to Australia in company with many others especially sent to embrace or resume University studies. My service with the 104th Batty. was unbroken by illness or casualty of any sort.
