Eng. III: Lieutenant, Light Trench Mortar Battery, 9th  
Brigade, A.I.F., France.

Enlisting 7th February, 1916, and sailing 13th May, was appointed sergeant 36th Battn. and sergeant-major for voyage. Commissioned lieutenant in September and, transferring to battery, crossed to France 21st November and served till death.

Killed in Action, near Armentières, 23rd December, 1916, and buried in Cité Bonjean Military Cemetery, Armentières.

A.M.F.: Lieutenant, 35th Infantry.
