Thank you so much for your congratulations.

Yes, I am indeed a proud woman – indeed I am like a cat with two tails, almost fear that I am “purring” audibly.

He’s a wonderful husband - this of mine, isn’t he?

I sent some details to M Bradley last week – Even George will be pleased to be included in ‘Hermes’, I’m sure – what a wonderful record it will be, & how wonderfully our thinking men have distinguished themselves in this war.
