In October transferred to Royal Scots as captain and adjutant, serving till 1917, although wounded on the Somme in 1916. Appointed M.O. Norfolk War Hospital in 1918 and in 1919 to Pilkington Special Orthopædic Hospital, St. Helen's, Lancs., later returning to Australia after severe illness. Mentioned in Despatches twice.
