Dear Mr. Hodge, I have just received your request for particulars about my son, Dr. H. B. Lucas, & am pleased to tell what I know.—

He was Captain in the R.A.M.C. & attached to the 7th Norfolk Regiment, as he went to England in March, February 1915 & joined there, — he was in camp at Eastbourne for a month, & since that time has been serving in France, at first in a Hospital in Rouen, then in a Field Hospital & later with the Regiment, living much in the trenches; but I am sorry to say he was reported as missing since 3rd July, & it was supposed he was an unwounded prisoner, but three weeks ago I had a cable that he was wounded & a prisoner, but up to now we have no later news, so the want
