Full details and remarks as to service:—

From Melbn to Suez where re-inf. employed establishing a camp for later re-inforcements - Left Port Said by SS Kashgar and disembarked Taranto. In hospital for a month (Flu) - Crossed Channel to Southampton from Salisbury to AETD in Essex - France Aug 14th 1918. joined 2nd Coy at Corbey - served in, and followed, advance from St Martin Wood & Proyant to Hindenberg line at Hargicourt - Withdrew to Somme in Sept (relieved by Americans) - Advanced again November 7th and were at small village near Grande Faye when Armistice signed - advanced in to Belgium (after going back to Bohain) via Soble-le Chateau - billeted at Linche (CRE. at Presles) near Charleroi - Was appointed Instructor under A.S.F. Education Service - on 21st Feb 1919 - reverted to Sapper on leaving unit 28th Feb 1919. - Embarked from Devonport for Australia returned via Cape.
