

Dr F Goodsmill left Adelaide with the  
1st Contingent on 20th October 1914 & was  
with the troops in the trenches at Gallipoli  
until the evacuation - he was not wounded  
but was bruised severely by being struck  
by a spent bullet.

He was amongst the first to go to France  
with the Australasian troops & has been  
close up in most of the big battles, &  
was at Pozieres.

When last writing he was in Flanders  
& expecting to be moved on again at once  
tho' unable to disclose where to.

He holds the rank of Major -  
and except for a few weeks leave  
in England, has been on duty  
the whole of the time.

He was for 7 months at the Baerham War  
being sent out by the British Red Cross
