Enlisting 21st April, 1915, was promoted acting sergeant and, sailing 14th October with reinforcements No. 2 Australian General Hospital, acted as sergeant in Q.M. store on troopship. After 5 months with hospital in Egypt crossed to France 1st April, 1916, and served for 5 months at Moussot Camp near Marseilles and later at Wimereux till invalided to England, and thence to Australia, arriving 29th November, 1917.
