We would like to bring forward for discussion by the clinic committee the following matter:-

As we frequently have patients referred from the Children's Hospital to this committee, we consider it would be adviseable to have liason officer attached to the clinic from the surgical staff of the Children's Hospital. He would be able to follow up the cases from the surgical aspect in the Children's Hospital in the same manner that they are in the staff of the Adelaide Hospital. This would be particularly opportune at the present, as Dr. J. Mayo is on the Children's Hospital staff and has had valuable experience in radiotherapy which would be useful to this committee and it is almost certain, that the Children's Hospital would appoint him if asked.

We would also like to bring up reccommendation that Adelaide Hospital staff be asked if they would approve of this action being taken, or altering the constitution of the committee to allow of it.
