Dear Sir,

Re your letter asking
for information of Cecil Madigan
I have much pleasure in sub-
mitting the following -
He enlisted from Oxford, as soon
as the war broke out.
He applied for a Commission in
the Royal Engineers, which he ob-
tained. After some months
training he became a full Lieut.
& was sent to the front.
After a few weeks there, he was
wounded & returned to England.
When his wound had healed suf-
ficiently, he worked at Vickers
& Co. for some time, & then at
Buxton. Finally in March 1916
he was again sent to France -
where he is now much interested
in the water schemes on the Somme
front.
