Rejoining bde. in April, 1917, served at Messines and Wytschaete, where again wounded in September, and a fourth time at Ypres 30th November, 1917, and invalided to London and Australia. Promoted lieutenant, 1st July, 1917. Awarded M.C. in September, 1917, and Mentioned in Despatches.
