THE REV. J. A. MALCOMSON.

TUMUT, Tuesday.

The death of the Rev. John Alexander Malcomson, Presbyterian minister at Tumut, Adelong, Batlow, and Gundagai, occurred at the Scottish Private Hospital, Paddington, after an illness lasting several months.

Mr. Malcomson came to Australia with his parents in early boyhood, and ministered at Auburn, Armidale, Ashford, Young, Cootamundra, and Temora. He had been at Tumut since 1930. During the war he was chaplain-major with the 31st Battalion in France. He was president of the Tumut sub-branch of the Returned Soldiers' League.

In 1912, Mr. Malcomson married Miss Ellen Jane Starling, daughter of the Rev. Hugh Starling, first minister at St. Stephen's Church, Sydney, and Mrs. Malcomson survives him.
