

## **MacCORMICK, SIR ALEXANDER.**

Then went with No. 3 Australian General Hospital to Lemnos, returning to Australia at the beginning of 1916. Re-embarking for France in May, 1917, served as Consulting Surgeon, British Army, St. Omer Area, returning to Australia at the beginning of 1918.
