

Enlisted on 27<sup>th</sup> December 1917 at Sydney. Embarked on 30<sup>th</sup> April 1918 at Sydney. Arrived a Suez on June 7<sup>th</sup>. Left for England via Italy & France July 29<sup>th</sup>. Arrived England August 7<sup>th</sup>. Left for France 6<sup>th</sup> October. Joined the 5<sup>th</sup> F.A.B. October 20; in the field. Remained with the Brigade until March 27<sup>th</sup> 1919 and then joined the A.I.F. Graves Detachment. Left France for England on August 12<sup>th</sup> 1919. Left England for Australia October 2<sup>nd</sup>. Arrived Sydney 28<sup>th</sup> November 1919.
