

## **POATE, HUGH RAYMOND GUY.**

M.B., Ch.M., F.R.C.S., F.R.A.C.S., L.R.C.P., Demonstrator in Anatomy : Lieutenant-Colonel, A.A.M.C., A.I.F., Gallipoli, Egypt and France.

Enlisting 20th August, 1914, and sailing 19th October with 1st Australian Field Ambulance, was at the Anzac Landing, then on " Carriers " with wounded to Alexandria and Malta till 10th August and, rejoining ambulance, remained at Anzac until the Evacuation. Transferring to No. 2 Australian General Hospital, Ghezireh, 24th December, 1915, and to H.Q., Cairo, 20th March, 1916, was appointed Senior Surgeon No. 3 A.G.H., Abbassia, crossing with it to Brighton in September and to Abbeville in March, 1917. Was detached to No. 12 British Casualty Clearing Station with surgical team from June to August and returned to Australia via Canada in October. Promoted major, 24th February, 1915 ; lieutenant-colonel, July, 1916.
