Full details and remarks as to service:— Left Australia on March 30th 1916. on the transport Port Sydney. "Star of Victoria". On arriving in Egypt, I was sent to Tel-el-Kebir and was attached to the 2nd Australian Stationary Hospital. After the Infantry and other Brigades left for France our hospital became attached to the Light Horse, and acted as the chief clearing station in all their engagements. Whilst stretcher bearing at El Arish I sustained the casualty which necessitated my return to Australia
