BORN 22-8-1897. DIED — \*  
 Prior to Enlistment served from Feb 19<sup>th</sup> 1916  
 at South Head and afterwards at Hawkesbury  
 Bridge Guard.  
 Enlisted A.M.C transferring 19<sup>th</sup> Nov 1916 to A.F.F.A.  
 Arrived in France 19<sup>th</sup> October 1917, became  
 casualty month later. Discharged from hospital  
 (No. 249) at Etaples 9<sup>th</sup> January and from Convalescent  
 Camp (No 5) at Bayeux March 19<sup>th</sup> Rejoined  
 Unit and after quiet period near Villers-  
 Bretonneux took part in subsequent attacks  
 from August 8<sup>th</sup> - 16<sup>th</sup> St Quentin being the best.  
 Peronne Baugicourt, Bellicourt, Hindenburg Line  
 etc., to Bussigny from where I went on Leave  
 on 19<sup>th</sup> October 1918. Celebrated Anniversary in London.
