 Full details and remarks as to service:—

Arrived at Suez on 18th December 1915. Trained six months in Egypt (Gallipoli having been evacuated) and sailed for France on 18th June 1916. Arrived Chasseilles on 26th June 1916. and took over from 14th Aust Division at Sailly in July. Spent 1916 winter on the Somme, afterwards following German withdrawal beyond Bapaume. Next move was to the Ypres sector where I was evacuated to England as a casualty in October 1917. Spent three months in Sir Southern Gen Hospital, Oxford, afterwards sent to Dartford then to Weymouth Convalescent Hosp. Left for home in April 1918. Treated five months at R'week Hosp and discharged.
