 1916 at Flers + was on the Somme for rest
 of the winter. Followed up the Germans in the
 first retreat from the Somme to Bullecourt
 Was invalided to England from Ypres
 October 1917 to England + rejoined the 3rd
 Battalion June 1918 in the attack on Morris
 + was stretcherbearing for the battalion
 from the 8th August till 17th September when
 was again wounded + invalided to England
 + thence to Australia leaving England 13th December
 1918
