Full details and remarks as to service:— 3½ years' service with various units in camps in Australia and England, on troopships "Kyarra" and "Themistocles" (as above), and with 2nd. A.I. Division in the field in France and Belgium (1 year & 8 months). Following is copy of certificate (original available) of services in France and Belgium.

"1. Hon. Capt. MAULDON, F.R.E., reported for duty at H.Q. Australian Corps on 24.6.17 and was ordered to England on 8.3.19.

2. During the period (as 1) he was attached for duties as under-noted and in the order given:

- 7th. Aust. Infantry Brigade. Y.M.C.A. Representative with Brigade. (13 months).
- 2nd. Aust. Divisional H.Q. In charge of Y.M.C.A. activities with this Division. (5 months).
- Charleroi Leave Club, Belgium. In charge of this large centre conducted for Australian Corps Leave troops and A.I.F. units located in area.
- Australian Corps H.Q. With Corps Y.M.C.A. Rep. creating Aust. Y.M.C.A. Historical Records Section.

3. For the period and in the capacities listed, his services proved highly satisfactory both to military and Y.M.C.A. authorities concerned. Certain testimonials from high Military Commanders as to his efforts on behalf of the A.I.F. are in this Association's files.

4. The whole of the duties now certified were performed with "fighting formations" and in the Army areas. Following casualty is recorded: "9.6.18 wounded fore arm h.e. shell; evacuated through Casualty Clearing Station".
