Full details and remarks as to service:—

Enlisted Jan 29; went into Casula camp on 31st Jan. Sent to Broadmeadows Camp, Victoria, at end of Feb. and embarked at Port Melbourne on 4th May. In training in Egypt. Sent to isolation camp and so missed unit (60th Batt.). Left Egypt 3/8/16, arrived Marseilles 8/8/16. Week in rest camp, then by train to Le Havre, and from Havre by boat to Southampton. Camps at Lark Hill and Codford. France 12/11/16. Joined 60th Battalion 1/12/16. Promoted ~~to~~ ^{to} corporal on 21/2/17. Wounded Hindenburg line at Bullecourt 12th May 1917. Sent to hospital in England. France again 5/3/18. Wounded Villers Bretonneaux 27/4/18. Hospitals France and England. Marked unfit for service. Left ~~for~~ ^{from} Liverpool 17/9/18. arrived Australia 20th/11/18. ^{Randwick Hos.} Discharged 24/12/18.
