I am in receipt of your circular letter dated 25<sup>th</sup> July in reference to the roll of names to be included in the War Memorial for the Union building.

I do not know of any additional name that should be included in your list but might I suggest that since names are referred to as wounded that this should be corrected.

The names marked refer to men wounded before 1917 only. I was wounded three times in 1917-8 and I know many on your list who were wounded but are not marked as such.

Again many decorations awarded after 1917 are not stated: if any are to be included at all I think that the list should be as complete as possible.
