 to Somme. At 5th O.C.B. Trinity College Cambridge
 April to July 1917, gained 3rd place (1st Australian)
 in final exam. for commission. Commissioned on 4/8/17
 + transferred to 13th Battalion. Served with this unit
 at Messines, Paschendael, Hebutome, Villers Bretonneux
 Hamel. Wounded 20/6/18. Hospital @ Rouen France +
 Wandsworth London until October 1918. Returned to Australia
 2/11/18 + D.M.V @ Perth on 1/4/19.
