I beg to apply for the position of Assistant to the Professor of Pathology.

My qualifications are M.B., B.S., 1st Class, Adelaide 1915, <sup>my</sup> age 27 in June 1921.

Prior to graduation my record was as follows:-

1909. Honours in Higher Public in Physics & Morganic Chemistry.

1910. First in S.A. of General List, <sup>Higher Public</sup> First on Honours List in Physics & Chemistry, Honours in Biology & Mathematics First Class in First & Fourth years of Medical Course.

Since graduation I have had 14 months in the Adelaide Hospital as house surgeon & house physician & have always taken a special interest in practical pathology having done a considerable number of autopsies & clinical pathology as opportunity offered.

My army service included 2 months at Keswick Base Hospital. Whilst on the staff of the 1st Australian Hospital Ship I acted for some time as pathologist. Later I was 2 years in France as regimental medical officer and was awarded the Military Cross.

During the past year my time was occupied in London doing post graduate work chiefly in the study of children's disorders.

If appointed I wish to use what spare time is available for the purpose of doing some research work.
