somewhere in Belgium. - He was, when he left
Adelaide, a Lance-Corporal in the Infantry, and
is now a Gunner in the trench-mortars. - His
address is "No. 244, Z 2 A, Trench-mortar battery
A. 1. 7." - He has been wonderfully well
all through, so far, and has not been wounded. -
