Transferring to 49th on 27th February, 1916, and crossing to France in June, was wounded at Pozières 14th August and again at Voormezeele 13th October. In 1917 served at Messines and Polygon Wood, and in 1918 on the Somme, returning in January, 1920. Promoted lieutenant, 1st November, 1916; captain, 26th July, 1917. Awarded M.C. 3rd June, 1918, and Mentioned in Despatches twice. President, Evening Students' Association. Early education at Ipswich Grammar School.
