Volunteering in March, 1915, for service with French Army and enlisting in Paris 7th July, served as Senior Surgeon to Hôpital Temporaire 22, Villers-Cotteret, Aisne, from June, 1916, to December, 1917, also as "Chirurgien Chef de Secteur" over seven other hospitals, including the "Scottish Women's" and at Clermont-Ferrand from January to June, 1918. Joining R.A.M.C. in London in July as captain, served at Shepherd's Bush, Woolwich and Officers' Hospital, Brighton, till demobilised in February, 1920. Awarded O.B.E. and Croix de Chevalier de la Légion d'Honneur.
