Enlisting 1st September, 1914, and sailing 20th October, served with 1st Australian Field Ambulance at Gallipoli from the Landing until the Evacuation. Crossing to France in March, 1916, was at Fromelles, Somme, Bullecourt, Menin Road, Ypres, Strazeele, Harbonnières and elsewhere until return with the original Anzacs in November, 1918.
