Enlisting in May, 1915, in A.A.M.C., joined hospital ship "Karoo" but, after one trip, was transferred to Infantry. Trained at Duntroon, sailed as sergeant, there being no vacancy for a commission, and served in many engagements in France till death.

Killed in Action, Hermies, 9th April, 1917, and buried in Beaumetz Cross Roads Cemetery, Beaumetz-les-Cambrai.

Early education at Lindfield and Chatswood Public and Fort St. High Schools. Later at Sydney Technical College and as an artist under Julian Ashton.
