Went to England via Panama Canal, landing in Glasgow. Spent 3 months in Flying Corps depot at Wendover (Bucks) then proceeded overland through France & Italy to Alexandria, thence to Palestine, joining squadron at El Deydel. Was with squadron up to armistice as despatch rider. Came home via Suez & Colombo.
