Dr. Elsie Dalyell was for some months Bacteriologist with Lady Wimborne's Servian Relief Fund Unit at Uskub. From the latest cable she is now Bacteriologist in connection with an English Hospital.

Dr. Isabel Ormiston is working among the Servian wounded.

Dr. Emma Buckley has a Scholarship at the Lister Institute in London.

Dr. Evelyn Dickinson is for the time being Superintendent of the Sanatorium at Nayland (Suffolk) for tuberculous patients, carrying on the work in conjunction with her own private practice.

Dr. Alexia Maclean is now Superintendent of the King's Tableland Sanatorium at Wentworth Falls. As a number of invalided soldiers are amongst the patients under her care, Dr. Maclean has received the rank of Captain in the R.A.M.C., the first woman in the Commonwealth to obtain such a distinction.

During the year four former students have married. Miss Dorothy Edwards (Mrs. Maurice Blackwood), Miss Laurie Edwards (Mrs. Wilson Ingram), Miss Donna Tearne (Mrs. Selwyn Lewis), and Miss F. A. Macdonald (Mrs. Alan Stewart).
