Dear Sir,

I beg to acknowledge receipt of Circular and Roll of Honour. The reference to myself is correct.

May I direct your attention to two names on the Roll:-

"†Dunstone, H.E., <sup>once again</sup> M.B., B.S." *malculated 1907*

and

*2 different persons*  
*H.M.S.* "Kollosche, H.F., <sup>and</sup> <sup>and</sup> M.B., B.S." *malculated 1909*

*and no others*  
I am wondering whether the names have been confused,

and for this reason :- Captain H.F.Kollosche was a member of the Unit I commanded in the A.I.F., namely the 11th Australian Field Ambulance. The Unit left South Australia for active service in May 1916, but prior to leaving Capt.Kollosche took the name, legally, of H.F.Dunstan. He was wounded at the Battle of Passchendael. I presume therefore that his name should be inscribed as:-

*and*  
*and* "†Dunstan, H.F., <sup>and</sup> <sup>and</sup> M.B., B.S." *on Roll*

Possibly it is also correct that Dr H.E.Dunstone served in the A.I.F., and was wounded, but as I said it may be that there has been a confusion of names.
