Tried to enlist in 1915 - Rejected owing to unfit eyesight.  
accepted in 1916. Attended a corporal's school at Moore  
Park. Embarked as temporary corporal. Attended an R.E.  
school of military engineering for officers & N.C.O.'s at  
Brightlingsea: subsequently left for France in October 1917  
to join 14 F.C.E. shortly after joining the company, I  
became company surveyor, & recommended by the O.C.  
for an officer. The Big Push began & I was gassed before  
anything eventuated. Spent 3 months in Norwich War  
Hospital - & invalided home on Hospital Ship Borda
