In answer to your request for information regarding Dr. C. Bollen in connection with the present War.

Dr. Bollen holds the rank of a Major. He left South Australia with the 8th. Field Ambulance last November and proceeded to Egypt, where he remained for several months, first in a camp near the canal and later he held a position as Sanitation Officer near Cairo. He left Egypt in the 15th. Field Ambulance and went to France. He has been stationed just outside Estaire near Ypres, quite close to the firing line, and his work has been in connection with both a Clearing and a Rest Station.

Major Bollen has hot been wounded but his time of service having expired, he is expected to return to South Australia in January next.
