In regards to the information you enquired for Re - A. R. Paterson, I may state, that in his last letter from Abroad, he was in the best of health. He has not been wounded. He has been to Egypt - England and is now "Somewhere in France"

While in Keswick Hospital he was Corp. Compounder and was about to get another stripe when he volunteered for the Front. In France he was allotted Hospital duties, but my eldest son claimed him for Field duties. They both left Adelaide as Privates, on April 11<sup>th</sup>/16. and are in the 14<sup>th</sup> Field Ambulance.
