In answer to your letter  
re University War Memorial —

I enlisted for active service in  
1918. After graduation I was  
attached to the A.F.M.C. with  
rank of Captain:

Although I enlisted before the  
Armistice was signed I was not  
called up until after the cessation  
of hostilities. I was not-abroad  
and my service was confined to a  
short-period of duty in No 7  
Australian General Hospital at

Keswick.

If your list-rolls include actual  
enlistments whether called up or  
not, then I am eligible for it.

I should not, however, like my  
name to appear as one who had  
been <sup>abroad</sup> on active service because  
that would be quite incorrect.
