Appointed C.O. 4th A.F.Amb. in May, 1918—Acting A.D.M.S. 4th Division for Battle of Hamel 4th July-and was A.D.M.S. from November to April, 1919, then returning for demobilisation. Promoted major, 6th February, 1916; lieutenant-colonel, 1st May, 1918. Awarded D.S.O. 1st January, 1918, and Order of White Eagle of Serbia (4th Class, with swords) and Mentioned in Despatches.
