MURRAY, DAVID MACLEAY.

B.E.: Private, 1st Battn., A.I.F., France.

Enlisting 6th August, 1915, and sailing as sergeant 12th Reinforcements, landed in Egypt in January, 1916, crossing to France in March, and serving at Fleurbaix and on the Somme till death.

Killed in Action, Flers, 5th November, 1916—at first "Reported Missing". Commemorated in Villers-Bretonneux Memorial.

Mathematics Prizeman.

Early education at Rawdon Island and Macksville Public School and Newington College (Dux).

Refused commission, saying "Everything good should go to Gallipoli boys."

"He would not have us mourn—that son of ours. Missing, not when King and Country called; Absent, not from fields where heroes fell; Missing, not from paths that Virtue trod; Nor Missing from the Honour Lists of God."—W.P.M.
