Enlisting 19th February, 1917, and sailing 19th December, arrived at Unit H.O., Baghdad, 29th March, 1918. Allotted to No. 9 Waggon Station, Kermanshah and Hamadan, N.W. Persia. Station moved on September 14th with Sweet's Column to Zingan, later returning to Baghdad via Siah Dehan and the Kasvin Road, arriving 21st November. On demobilisation of the Squadron, transferred to "D" Troop which remained in Mesopotamia until 11th November, 1919, owing to frontier operations in Kurdistan (Mosul area), returning in January, 1920.
