 Sent overseas January 1915 & posted to 106 Battery R.F.A. VIIth Division.
 Invalided home March 1916. Granted Temporary Lieutenant 16-8-16 and full Lieut (1.9.16) seniority (23.12.16) in the Special Reserve of officers.
