Full details and remarks as to service:—

Left Sydney Dec '15 arrived Suez Jan 1916, disembarked, sent to Cairo, then to Zeitoun Camp attached 5th Training Bn. Moved to Tel-el Kebir thence to England via Port Said per SS Franconia. On Salisbury Plains some weeks, then attached No 2? A.G.H. at Wimereux. Joined 4th Div at Reninghelst Sept 21 1916 drafted to 13 F.Amb. Soon after joined 49th Bn as R.M.O. Served with this unit for one year, rejoining the Ambulance shortly before the end of 1917. About May 1918 was sent No 3 A.G.H at Abbeville. Was there until after the Armistice. Rejoined the 13th F.Amb and sent to the Charleroi region. Returned to London Feb 1919 given 6 months at the Boscombe Hospital near Bournemouth. Sept 21st 1919 embarked from Tilbury on SS Port Denison returning to Australia via the Cape. Disembarked Sydney Nov 16 1919.
