Enlisting 20th November, 1915, and sailing 15th December, was at No. 2 Australian General Hospital, Ghezireh, till February, 1916, R.M.O. 11th Field Artillery Brigade till September, and then at Salisbury Plain till July, 1917. Returning to France, served with 1st and 4th Australian Field Ambulances till demobilisation, being R.M.O. 15th Battn. till October, 1918. Awarded M.C.* and Mentioned in Despatches.
