the war, in which you ask if I can
supply any information in regard to Mr.
G. W. G. Ponder, I am enclosing herewith
a brief account of his military career so
far as I know it.

Mr. Gilbert Walter Graham Ponder,
son of Mr. Walter J. Ponder, of Adelaide,
enlisted for service abroad on May
30. 1915. He was drafted into the
8th Field Ambulance and sailed from
Melbourne on the 10th November, 1915.
On his arrival in Egypt he served
there for seven months. During part
of this time he was ill with fever in a
Hospital. When the armies were reorganised
in Egypt he was transferred into the
15th Field Ambulance, but owing to
his illness was unable to leave for France
with his unit. He then joined the 4th
Training Battalion, and left with this
Battalion for England in June, 1916. He
is now on Salisbury Plains, and when
last heard from was well.
